

Dear All

If I might introduce myself by way of sending you two articles which have appeared in newspapers over the last few years.

After becoming E.S. in 2000, like many people after an unproductive meeting with my doctor, and after speaking to the N.R.P.B., I hid away, reluctant to talk about this condition because it was labelled psychosomatic.

However, after listening to many stories from sufferers, and seeing much research that explained why this happened, I have decided that I had to speak out on behalf of other sufferers and to try and get the Government, N.R.P.B and doctors to treat this condition more seriously.

I became a trustee of the radiation Research Trust approximately three years ago, a group of individuals trying to communicate the research that is published from around the world to the authorities in the U.K., showing why peoples' health is suffering as a result of E.M.F.

More recently I became a trustee of E.S. UK, because my passion and objective is to get this condition recognised and the suffering of people who are affected recognised as a medical condition.

It is a struggle because the economic forces against us are enormous. The mobile phone industry, the Government, and the N.R.P.B. do not recognise this condition because of the consequences to 'the economy' if it is true.

Sadly, the longer they leave it, the more seriously people will be affected, and the consequences for our children will be tragic.

Recently, the removal of Rod Read from the position of managing the trust has caused some consternation.

The background of this is very difficult to discuss, given the confidentiality of such an event. I can assure everyone that this has happened fairly and considerately, although inevitably with some difficulties. No one is happy being removed from their position, and the appeal process continues.

I am confident that the new trustees that have been appointed to E.S. UK, which sadly, Rod has tried to prevent, are E.S. sufferers who intend to grow the organisation, and ensure it is run more professionally.

I enclose my contact details if people wish to talk to me about it, but remember, some items must remain confidential.

During the course of next year, a conference on E.S. and the dangers of wireless communication will be organised and we will keep in touch with you when it is taking place.
